

Manager, Solid Organ Transplant/CNS

The Solid Organ Transplant (SOT) Manager/ Clinical Nurse Specialist has the responsibility to maintain and provide oversight for the organizational systems associated with leading activities related to the referral process, evaluation, consultation, and treatment of children requiring a solid organ transplant. In partnership with the physician and administrative leaders, takes a leadership role in planning, developing, marketing and evaluating aspects of the SOT program in supporting the mission and strategic objectives of this program. Provides leadership to monitor clinical processes and outcomes and system issues related to the quality of care provided, identifies trends and participates in the resolution across the continuum of care for solid organ transplant programs. Provides direct supervision for the transplant coordinators and support staff of the program. Exercises a high degree of initiative, judgment, and discretion in decision-making and demonstrates effectiveness in operations.

Master's Degree in Advanced Practice Nursing with focus as clinical nurse specialist.

A current license to practice professional nursing in the State of Wisconsin.

Proficiency in complex professional and administrative skills acquired through 23 years of clinical experience related to program specialty.

Experience in **program development** preferred.

Current CPR certification - Basic Life Support (BLS) for Healthcare Providers through American Heart or American Red Cross is required.

Requires independent judgment to develop, implement and monitor care practices in area of expertise in order to ensure quality care and cost effective service.

A high level of analytical ability to resolve complex patient care problems, administrative problems and research issues. Interpersonal skills which frequently involve collaborating with peers and supervisors, physicians, and administrators on policy and procedural issues.
